OLD BUSINESS:

- Approval of Minutes from August 14, 2023 - Brandy made a motion to accept the minutes, Ali 2nd the motion. Motion passed unanimously

PRINCIPAL REPORT: - PRINCIPAL WALLS

- School enrollment is at 528 students. We have passed the 10 day drop point and no changes are needed.
- Teaching assistant which is serving as a general classroom support has been filled.
- Paraprofessional for Self Contained Ex-Ed is vacant.
- Interviews will be conducted for campus monitor positions
- Part time resources teacher will be hired to work with kids who have an IEP
- Lineweaver is 1 of 17 schools that doesn't have a school psychologist. IEPs need to be evaluated. The district lead is working with Principal Walls but this is moving very slowly.
- Open house was completed now teacher conferences are happening soon
- All clubs and interscholastics have been assigned. Now choir, ukulele, and cross country have started
- The district has created an instructional framework backed by educational research, new practices, and initiatives. Teachers will receive training.
- This year there will be a focus on mission and vision. It is time to look at verbiage and make sure that it is reflective of the school and community.
- 1st week in october will be quarter 1 testing

BUDGET

- Homework folders and classroom teacher supplies line item is closed
- The uncategorized line item is at \$6871.38 and that is the amount over the \$15,000.00 of our operating budget
