DISCUSSION NOTES	Enrollment 521 students Staffing: Started with some openings. Openings; 4 <sup>th</sup> grade, reading interventionist, counselor, Self-contained ED classroom. As of today, we have a reading interventionist starting 9-26-25, a counselor who started 9-8-25, Full time ED teacher started 9-2-25. 4 <sup>th</sup> grade position has been posted, and applicants are being reviewed. MTSS facilitator will be posted soon. A new monitor has been interviewed and hopefully will be hired, a parent who has volunteered at LW. Behavior interventionist has been hired but doesn't have a start date yet. 3 Teacher assistant positions have all been hired. One one-on-



one for a  $3^{\rm rd}$  grade student and two in the ED classroom. Library assistant position has been posted.

**New & Noteworthy:** The i-Ready diagnostic is almost complete, one kinder class to go. DIBELS is all complete. Math interventions started the week of 9-8-25 as well with Ms. Gregory.

**PLC's** have been embedded during the school day this year. Specials teachers have students while classroom teachers meet for 45 minutes each week.

**Channel 13** is coming to our school on Friday to feature our new visual arts teacher Mrs. Trista Tamura. Her position is funded through an endowment and Channel 13 wants to feature her and interview students for a story.
